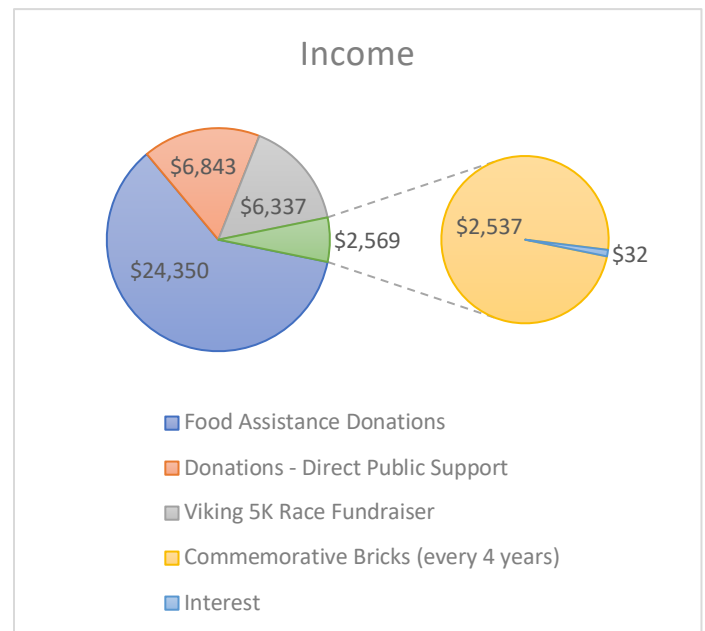

President's Report

For 15 years, the Lakeside Foundation has proudly served the Lakeside High School community. Our goal is to support our students and staff in their academic, arts, and athletic pursuits through fundraising, grant allocations, and scholarships. Generous donations from parents, community members, businesses, and other foundations have allowed us to continue to serve our community, even during the uncertainty of a global pandemic. The 2020-2021 school year presented unique challenges. In response to families in the Lakeside



community who were experiencing food insecurity, the Lakeside Foundation distributed \$24,350 in grocery store gift cards. A \$7,261 grant allocation funded cleaning and disinfecting equipment, so that students and staff could more confidently return to the school building. An additional \$8,216 funded

grants for special education, arts education, facilities improvements, and general academic support. Two of the many outstanding LHS students received scholarships to pursue their college careers.

The Lakeside Foundation’s only annual fundraiser, the Viking 5K Race, was held virtually in 2021, but we are back this year with a live race scheduled for January 22, 2022.
