Before submitting your essay, take the time to perform a thorough review, carefully editing for grammatical and spelling errors.

The essay should be 750-1,000 words, 12pt, double-spaced.

Please answer the following question:

Evaluate a significant experience, risk you have taken, or ethical dilemma you have faced and its impact on you.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ESSAY:

The document **MUST** be saved in Word (.doc) format (unprotected), and named with the applicant's last name, then first name, followed by the word "Essay" (example: Smith, Jane Essay). The document should then be transmitted to lhsfscholarship@gmail.com as an attachment.
